

Just some dates to remember and a notice I received from the Bayfield County Tourism people.

\*ATV meeting will be at 7:00 pm on August 11<sup>th</sup> at Boogies Iron River Saloon.

\*ATV ride to Barnes on Saturday August 14<sup>th</sup>. Meet at Iron River Auto parts at 10:30 as usual and we'll leave from there.

On Tuesday, July 20th, the County Board passed a resolution opening all designated ATV TRAILS in Bayfield County that are NOT under National Forest jurisdiction to registered UTVs as part of the UTV Pilot Program. Road Routes open to ATVs have been open since May 26th and the Tri-County Corridor opened on July 10th. Trails and roads under National Forest jurisdiction are NOT open to UTVs over 50 inches wide.
